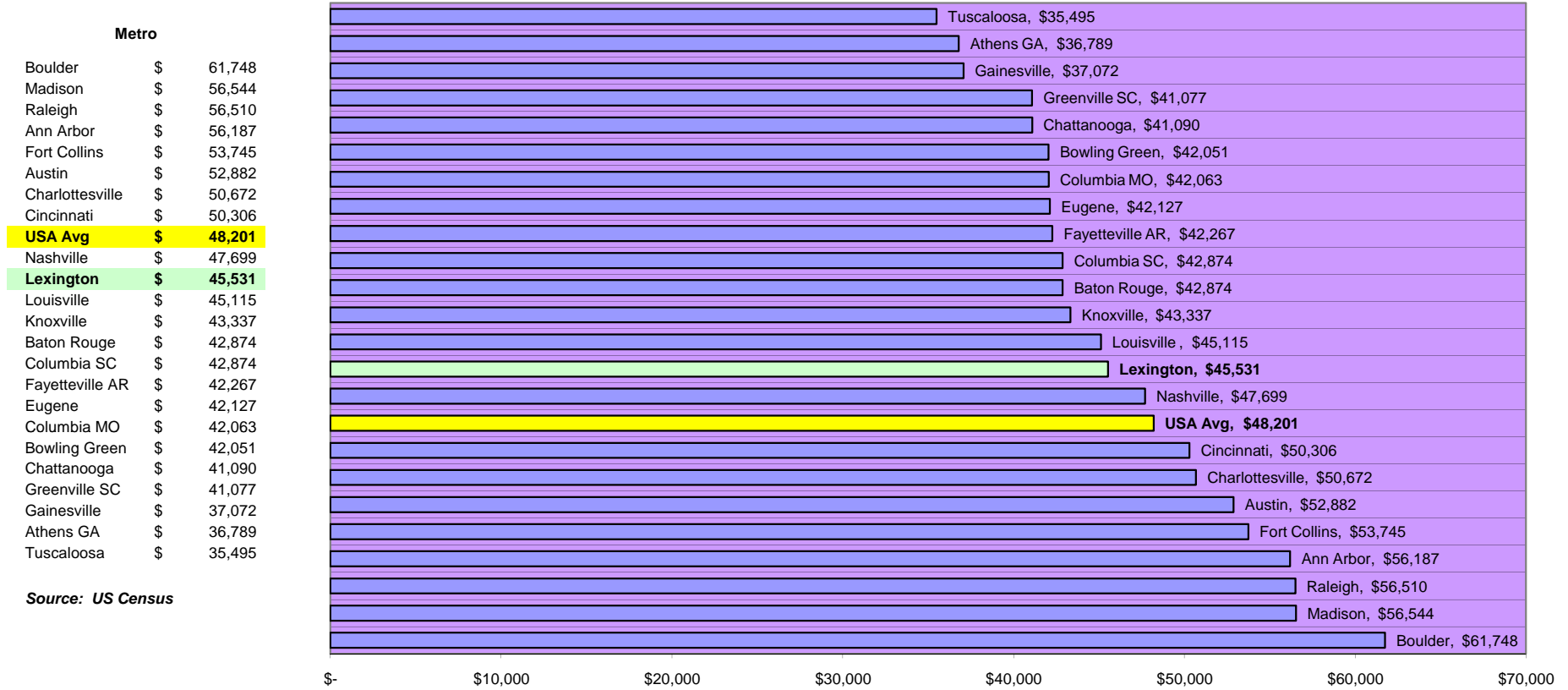


2006 Median HH Income \$
